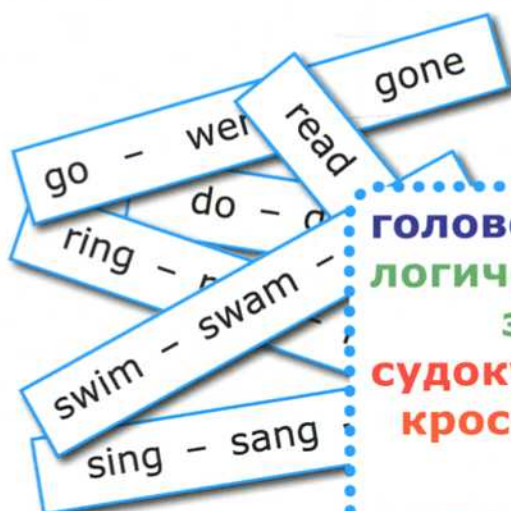

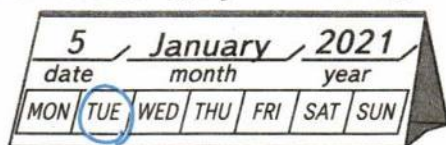


## Информация для родителей

Этот сборник предназначен для занятий на каникулах. Он содержит большое количество кроссвордов, головоломок, заданий на развитие памяти и внимания.

- Вся книга разделена на двадцать дней.

Каждый день ребёнок **записывает дату** и отмечает день недели:



Если ребёнок увлётся и хочет продолжить работу, то на следующей странице он пишет ту же дату и продолжает выполнять задания.

- Ключи даны во вкладке. У вас есть возможность вынуть вкладку из книжки: не будет соблазна подсмотреть ответ. Но если вы путешествуете, то лучше оставить вкладку на месте, чтобы она не потерялась.
- Обратите внимание: ключи мы даём вразбивку. Это делается для того, чтобы ребёнок, проверяя одно задание, случайно не увидел ответ к следующему. Страница, где дан ключ, указана в каждом задании следующим образом: 10

Все номера на странице даны по возрастанию.

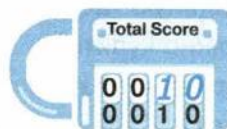
- В конце дня есть табличка **PERSONAL SCORE RECORD**.

## ОТВЕТЫ НА ЧАСТО ЗАДАВАЕМЫЕ ВОПРОСЫ

### Вопрос 1. Почему нужно заниматься во время каникул?

Школьные каникулы, включая летние, осенние, зимние и весенние, длятся четыре месяца. За такое длительное время дети многое забывают. Вспомните космонавтов в условиях невесомости. Чтобы не потерять способность двигаться, им приходится заниматься на тренажерах. Наш мозг можно условно сравнить с мышцами: если его оставить без работы, он быстро растеряет знания и навыки, с таким трудом усвоенные в учебном году. Единственный способ не забыть то, что учил, — продолжать заниматься.

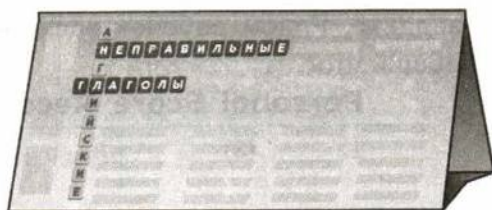
### Вопрос 2. Как заставить ребёнка заниматься на каникулах?

С нашими сборниками «АНГЛИЙСКИЙ ЯЗЫК НА КАНИКУЛАХ» заставлять не придётся. Детям очень нравятся головоломки, кроссворды, логические задачи. Задания доступные, увлекательные, интересные. Они активизируют внимание и мышление, тренируют память.

### Вопрос 3. Почему целая тетрадь посвящена неправильным глаголам?

Неправильные глаголы необходимо знать так же прочно, как таблицу умножения. Школьные учебники не отводят на изучение этой темы достаточно времени, поэтому возникает необходимость в дополнительной отработке.

В дополнение к тренажёру мы разработали специальную таблицу-домик. Его можно купить в интернет-магазине **Ozon.ru**.



### Вопрос 4. А сколько всего неправильных глаголов?

*Около четырёхсот.*

### Вопрос 5. И все четыреста нужно выучить?!

Нет, конечно. В начальной школе достаточно выучить самые частотные. Это около пятидесяти глаголов. В средней школе словарь расширяется, нужно выучить ещё полсотни глаголов. Среди неправильных глаголов есть те, которые не входят в активный словарь школьника. Их мы учить не будем.

## Вопрос 6. Только неправильные глаголы имеют три формы?

Нет, все глаголы имеют три формы: и правильные и неправильные.

Собственно, глаголы называются неправильными потому, что при образовании второй и третьей формы они «не желают» подчиняться правилу. Во всём другом они ничем не отличаются от правильных. Есть неправильные глаголы, у которых вторая и третья формы одинаковы (*get — got — got, buy — bought — bought, have — had — had*). А у части глаголов вторая и третья формы отличаются друг от друга (*do — did — done, go — went — gone, speak — spoke — spoken*). Но и неправильные и правильные глаголы имеют три формы.

## Вопрос 7. Почему лучше выполнять задания карандашом?

Если ребёнок пропустил слово или неправильно написал его, то балл не засчитывается. Работа карандашом позволяет стереть написанное, выполнить задание ещё раз и получить максимальное количество очков. Лучше писать мягким карандашом (В, 2В, 6В): стереть написанное будет легче. Рекомендуется не сразу переделывать задание, а вернуться к нему через некоторое время. Так ребёнок ещё раз поработает с трудным для него материалом. И тетрадь будет аккуратной, без исправлений и зачёркиваний.

## Вопрос 8. Тетрадь рассчитана на двадцать дней. А что делать в оставшиеся дни каникул?
