- About 20,000 people lived there. Many people were farmers. The land close to Pompeii was very good for growing things because of ash from the volcano. Mount Vesuvius. In the summer, many rich Romans went to Pompeii. There were big houses, beautiful theaters, and other buildings.
- 2 Ash and rocks started to come out of Mount Vesuvius and go up into the sky. Soon, the ash and rocks started falling to the ground. It was difficult to breathe and see. The ash and rocks buried the city of Pompeii and killed many people.
- Then, in the 18th century, some explorers discovered the city under six meters of rock and ash. Archeologists started digging and were amazed to find the city was almost the same as in A.D. 79. There were even jars of fruit and loaves of bread! Archeologists are still working in Pompeii today.
- When you visit Pompeii, it's like going back in time. You can see the bodies of the people who died, as well as buildings, furniture, pots, food, and some graffiti. You can also walk down the streets and go inside houses, shops, and cafés.

DERORESTATION

The world's forests are very important. Trees make oxygen, and without oxygen we can't breathe. So why do we cut down an area of forest bigger than 20 football pitches every minute? We should protect our trees, not cut them down.

Why do people cut down trees?


There are more people in the world now than ever before. All those people need food and houses. People cut down forests to make space for bigger farms so we can produce more food. They also cut down forests to make space for buildings, and they use the wood to build houses.

What are the effects of deforestation?

Trees turn bad air into oxygen, so when we cut them down we haven't got as much fresh air to breathe. Also, 70 percent of Earth's animals and plants live in forests. Without their food or habitat, animals and plants cannot live. Trees also protect us from the sun, wind and rain. With fewer trees, the Earth gets hotter and there are more floods.

What can we do?

Paper comes from trees. If we use paper carefully, and reuse and recycle our paper, we can help save more trees. Teaching people about the effects of deforestation is really important too. We should also plant as many trees as possible.

In **Dakar**, Senegal, it's midday and children are starting their lunch break. But it's not the same everywhere. **Lima**, Peru, is five hours behind Dakar

time. It's seven o'clock in the morning there, and children are getting up. In **Vancouver**, Canada, it's only 3 a.m., and most people are still fast asleep. ASTRONAUT

Did you know that astronauts sometimes have other jobs first? They can be engineers, science teachers or scientists. Then they have to train to be an astronaut for two years.

The US space programme is in Houston, Texas. There the trainee astronauts study science, Moths, medicine and languages. One important language for working on the international Space Station is Russian because the Control Centre is in Russia. The trainees also practise living without gravity in special machines. IMY ANTARCTIC EXPERIENCE

Today is the start of my second week working on the Antarotic Meteorite Programme. The team all come from different countries, but we love working together:

Yesterday was an exciting day. We got ready to go look for space rocks, as we do every morning. We have to put on special clothes, but not too many. We walk a lot when we are looking for meteorites, and we get hot. But we have to be careful not to sweat. In the freezing temperatures of Antaratica, it can be very dangerous to have wet clothes. It's because your body loses heat much more quickly when your clothes are wet.



We travelled on our snowmobiles to an area whose there's lots of ice. It's easier to find meteorites on the ice because they're black and we can see them from far away. They're also in very good condition because they don't change in the cold weather.

As we got closer to the ice, I noticed a black spot in the distance. I couldn't believe it - my first meteorite! I picked it up and put it inside a special plastic bag so we can take it home and study it. Meleorites come from asteroids, the Moon or even Mars. 





Whistling rats live in the Kalahari Desert in southern Africa. The Kalahari is a very dry habitat. There's no rain in the winter for six to eight months. It's hot during the day, but temperatures can fall to -12 degrees Celsius at night. The ground is sandy, and there aren't many plants or trees.

Whistling rats have sandy-colored fur and this helps them hide in the desert. They have short, round ears, and they can hear very well. They give a loud whistle when a snake or a bird comes close. Then they run very quickly and jump into their holes underground. They're usually herbivores, and they eat plants not far from home, so they can escape easily when danger is close.

Kalahari lions also adapted to life in the desert. They have long, thin legs, and bigger paws than other lions. This helps them travel long distances to look for food and water. Kalahari lions can go up to two weeks without drinking water! They get some water from the animals they eat.

They live in smaller groups than other lions. This is because there aren't many big animals for them to hunt, so they eat animals like antelopes, birds, porcupines, and mice. These are also easier to catch, so the lions don't waste energy.

To cool down, they lie on their backs with their mouths open and their paws facing upward. This is because they sweat through their paws and mouths.
